

Summary: The Purchaser will purchase items on a monthly basis for use in the classrooms and the WTG facility. There may be a need to research costs for new equipment or capital investments.

Estimated Time Commitment: 1-2 hours per month

Responsibilities

Purchase items needed prior to fall quarter. Instructors will send a list in August for items to bring to WTG at the beginning of September prior to the start of classes.

Purchase items needed on a monthly basis. Instructors will provide a purchasing list during the last week of each month, for items needed the following month. Specific days may be given for date needed by.

Label all newly-purchased items with "WTG," using a black permanent marker. It is helpful to label prior to bringing to class. Black markers are available at WTG to take home for your use. Most items can just be brought with you to class, unless another delivery time/place is specified.

Put away items purchased in appropriate places, after they are properly labeled. See instructors with any questions.

- <u>Snack supplies</u> should be placed in, or on top of, the tubs located to the left side shelves in the outdoor storage shed. Match items to the list of contents written on the outside of the tubs.
- Food items must be stored indoors in the tall locking cupboard in the green room.
- <u>Perishables</u>, such as vegetables, are stored in the church kitchen refrigerator after marking with "WTG."
- Other items may be placed in the outdoor storage shed, or in the curriculum tubs provided in the art supplies closet in the green room.

Purchase any items for special events or projects (for example, paper products for the end of the year picnic), as requested by the Parent Board of Directors.

Research items for purchase, as requested by the Parent Board of Directors or Instructors. This may include equipment and furniture, or facility upgrades such as flooring.

Complete a check request form for reimbursement, attach all receipts, and submit the request to the President's mail folder for approval. Purchase all items for WTG on a separate receipt from any personal purchases. Contact the Treasurer with any questions.

Check mail folder in the green crate on the sign-in table on a weekly basis. Reimbursement checks are typically left in your mail folder by the Treasurer.

Board Duties: Purchaser is not required to attend Board meetings.
