



What is Unique About WTG's Little Learners Class?

- The Little Learners class is the only class we offer for children (and parents!) who are not quite ready to separate for drop-off preschool. We give parents the opportunity to be close by and participate while still allowing the toddler to expand his/her world.
- Emphasis is placed on large and fine motor development, social skills, friendships and self-regulation. Introductory activities with ABC's, 123's are also part of the curriculum.
- We offer varied opportunities for your child to explore, and build their budding independence! The environment is set up to meet the developmental needs of 2.5 – 3.5 year-olds.
- The curriculum calendar and the in-class parenting education are altered from our 2-3 year old class to meet the needs of our “more mature” learners and their parents. All families at Woodinville Toddler Group experience the same evening parenting education and family events.
- Each parent/child packs and brings a nutritious snack/lunch for themselves, allowing children to build self-help skills both at home and at WTG.
- We offer a variety of songs, instruments, puppets, and music during circle time. This class will move toward turn-taking and individual participation during circle games and stories.
- Children are encouraged to help with most clean-up and prep duties at WTG .
- Our Little Learners instructor is experienced working with preschool and elementary aged children.
- Little Learners is an excellent follow-up to our 1.5-2.5 year old class.
